#### **JOB PURPOSE:**

Ensure that a high level of cleanliness is maintained throughout the boarding houses (bedrooms, bathrooms and communal areas) on a daily basis through the completion of cleaning tasks and routines including:

- Sweeping and mopping of all hard floors
- Vacuuming and spot stain removal of all carpeted floors
- Emptying litter bins and removal of waste to designated area, including the separation of waste, i.e. recycling
- Polishing and dusting surfaces and fixtures and fittings
- replenishment of paper towels, toilet rolls and other disposables

Each cleaner will be responsible for cleaning an area as allocated by the Cleaning Supervisor and will be expected to clean to the frequency and standards set out.

The post holder will be expected to:

- Use appropriate equipment and materials as directed by the Cleaning Supervisor
- notify line management or other Senior member of staff, of any damage to buildings and equipment or anything that may be dangerous to pupils or staff
- inform the Cleaning Supervisor of matters requiring attention e.g. light bulb replacement, blocked toilets, damage to fixtures & fittings
- undertake training in the correct use of cleaning equipment and materials as appropriate
- At all times to carry out the duties in accordance with school policies and Health and Safety procedures
- use only approved cleaning materials and in accordance with manufacturers printed instructions and COSHH regulations
- participate in the School's appraisal scheme

#### Other duties:

 Undertake other tasks or duties which may be reasonably assigned by the Cleaning Supervisor, Housemaster or Site Manager and/or the Estates & Operations Manager
