Dear Applicant,

On behalf of the Governors of Lytham Hall Park Primary School and Nursery, I would like to thank you for your interest in the position of Nursery Practitioner.

Lytham Hall Park is an over-subscribed community primary school and nursery catering for over 400 children between the ages of three and eleven years. We are a school housed in a modern building, with beautiful grounds, which we use regularly. We have a forest school onsite which is led by a member of our team. We are a two-form entry primary school with an admission number of 60 pupils each year and a nursery.

The appointed candidate will be a highly motivated Nursery Practitioner, who will work in our school nursery with children of pre-school age (3-4 years). We value positive relationships between home and school, knowing that this is the key to our children's happiness and confidence in school, resulting in their achievement. The successful candidate will have the ability and commitment to build, maintain and nurture these important relationships.

Successful candidates need to be positive, nurturing and highly motivated and would need to be dedicated to high quality teaching and also understand the value of play both indoors and out.

Candidates must have experience of working within an Early Years setting with children from 3-4 years and will have a good working knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework.

The successful candidates will be fully involved in the teaching, learning and assessment of children in the nursery and would be expected to confidently deliver a range of activities to meet the specific needs of individual children.

As a Nursery Practitioner, you will play a vital role in our school team. The successful candidate will be resilient, confident, able to communicate effectively and have the ability to relate to both children and adults. We look forward to hearing about your experience in your application.

The position is 23 ½ hours a week. The working week is Monday to Friday 8.30am-1.00pm and also requires attendance at our weekly Early Years Team meeting on Mondays from 3.45pm to 4.45pm. This position is term time only plus 23 ½ hours during school holidays. If successful, the salary received will be paid on a pro-rata basis.
