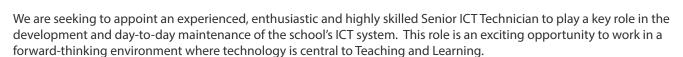

The successful applicant will be expected to work alongside the Strategic Lead for Whole School ICT to ensure reliable, efficient and secure ICT provision across the school. You will provide both technical support and practical solutions to ensure that staff and pupils can make the most effective use of ICT in their daily work.

All staff currently have access to an individual Windows 11 device which connects via a Microsoft wireless connector on a TV screen within each classroom. The vast majority of our endpoint devices have now been migrated to Windows 11. We have recently invested in a new infrastructure including new switches and Wi-Fi solutions.

Looking ahead, we are continuing to develop our cloud-based strategy using Microsoft 365, supporting the migration of both staff and pupil data to cloud storage. As Senior ICT Technician, you will play a vital role in ensuring the smooth running of the school's ICT systems at a time of significant modernisation and technological development. You will be responsible for providing high-quality technical support, resolving ICT issues, maintaining network reliability, and assisting with the implementation of new technologies.

You should have:

- A strong working knowledge of ICT systems, networking and troubleshooting techniques
- Experience managing Windows operating systems, cloud platforms (especially Microsoft 365)
- A proactive, solution-focused approach and a commitment to continually improving ICT provision for staff and pupils

Purpose of the Role

With reference to or guidance from the Strategic Lead for Whole School ICT, facilitate the provision of ICT support including the maintenance of equipment, use of software and continued effectiveness of a school network for all aspects of Teaching and Learning and administration. This post is full time, all year and permanent.

Accountabilities/Responsibilities

- Maintain a comprehensive database of all support requests
- Provide technical support to staff and pupils. Leading on all helpdesk tickets with escalation as needed
- Identify school staff training issues and provide assistance and advice to staff and pupils within own levels of expertise, escalating gueries and problems and higher-level requests to the strategic Lead of Whole School ICT
- To undertake the daily support of ICT classrooms to ensure that they are resourced and maintained in safe and effective working order
- First line support for systems including Wi-Fi, Cashless catering, printing, Cloud solutions
- Create and manage Staff and Pupil network user accounts, ensuring correct access rights
- Ensure data stored on the system is current and out of date data archived
- Support the use of Office 365 including Teams, Exchange and OneDrive
- Work alongside the Strategic Lead for Whole School ICT to design and implement changes to the schools ICT software and hardware
- Management of hardware spares, getting prices for orders by the Strategic Lead for Whole School ICT. Updating audit inventory as required
- Carry out audits of pupil and staff internet usage, add filters where necessary and report as appropriate in line with school policy
- To work within school policies and procedures
- To take care of their own and other people's health and safety
- To configure, test, support and maintain a varied range of hardware including desktops, laptops, printers and tablet computers within the school
- Assist in the supervision of ICT technician
- To perform such duties consistent with your role as may from time to time be assigned to you anywhere within the school
- Support adherence to ICT policies, including those relating to safeguarding and internet usage and report any concerns
