Dear Applicant,

On behalf of the Governors of Lytham Hall Park Primary School, I would like to thank you for your interest in the position of class teacher. It is envisaged this post will be in KS2, and most likely in upper Key Stage 2. This might be in Year 5 or Year 6 – and we want someone to join our team who is excited and enthused about teaching this age range. Although we are interested in teachers who already have experience of teaching in Year 5 or in Year 6, we welcome passionate teachers who have experience in any primary year group but want the change to upper Key Stage 2 and see this as an exciting professional opportunity.

Lytham Hall Park is an over-subscribed community primary school catering for over 400 children between the ages of four and eleven years. Our most recent (January 2018) OFSTED report states *'Pupils' positive attitudes towards learning contribute effectively to the progress that they make. They are polite, courteous and confident.'* We are a school housed in a modern building with semi open plan style classrooms and beautiful grounds which we use regularly. We have a forest school onsite which is led by a member of our team. We are a two form entry primary school with an admission number of 60 pupils each year. Our school has recently benefited from a significant building project providing six new classrooms, together with a music room, a nurture room and a purpose built assembly hall, large enough to accommodate all our pupils. The whole school assemblies which we currently hold are in keeping with our family ethos, which is extremely important to us all.

Our aim is to appoint an experienced teacher who is excited to join us and who recognises and embraces our successful history but is also able to develop and introduce their own ideas and personality into our school. There is much to be proud of within Lytham Hall Park but also an appetite to continue to grow and improve. We have a staff team who endeavour to create in our children a true love of learning.


