Thank you for your interest in the position of full-time, temporary nursery teacher at All Saints, Hesketh-with-Beconsall. We are Christian school who pride ourselves at putting children at the heart of all we do. Our nursery team work closely with Reception to ensure that our children have the foundation skills they need to flourish as they move throughout school.

Excellent communication and organisation skills are essential for this post. The nursery teacher would be expected to lead on a curriculum area and support the other teachers in this field. Completed applications should be returned to the Headteacher at the school – either by email, post or hand delivered. If you are invited to interview you will also be asked to teach a short lesson either here at our school or in your current setting.
