Thank you for showing an interest in the vacancy at Weeton Primary School; the separate Role Profile (Job Description) and Person Specification outline the requirements of the post. Although the post is initially temporary, there is a strong likelihood that it will become permanent from September 2023.

The Governors are seeking to appoint somebody who can really make a positive difference to our 'outstanding' school. Ideally, we are looking for an experienced and skilled teacher who is looking for the next step in their career – we have a proven track record of developing staff and giving them the skills and experience to gain promotions into leadership roles. They will be comfortable based initially in either Year 2 or a mixed Year 4/5 class and be confident in leading one or two curriculum areas throughout school. The ability to lead Computing, PE, RE or Geography would be an added bonus. A sense of fun and the ability to bring about enthusiasm in the learning environment would be essential.

The school is located on Weeton Barracks, with the majority of children coming from Service families. We presently have 182 children on roll although we will be reducing to approximately 115 in September due to a Regiment move. The number of children on roll will increase significantly again in the next few years. 
