Overton St Helen's Church of England Primary School is a slightly smaller than average primary school with around 175 pupils organised into six classes. Our catchment includes the villages of Overton and Middleton, however each year we take a number of children from Heysham too. We organise our pupils into single aged classes in EYFS/KS1 and mixed age classes in KS2 as we feel this provides the best provision for our pupils' learning.
