

The Baines Trust

Baines is very fortunate to have the financial support of the Baines Trust, set up back in 1717. The Trust manages the legacy of James Baines and their generous support of around £70k over the last five or so years is very much appreciated.

Two of our governors are Trustees and the Trust is made up of seven individuals. The Trust usually meets a couple of times a year and will assess the school's funding requests that benefit children at Baines, as well as supporting a number of standing items.

Their support has enabled our music provision, helped our outdoor learning, purchased IT equipment and other much needed resources, as well as in the past, significant investment in building works.
