Thank you for showing an interest in the vacancy at Weeton Primary School; the separate Role Profile (Job Description) and Person Specification outline the requirements of the post. Although the post is initially temporary, there is a strong likelihood that it could become permanent from September 2025.

The Governors are seeking to appoint somebody who can really make a positive difference to our school. Our NOR are due to increase significantly this summer when we welcome a new regiment so we are restructuring our KS1 classes. Ideally, we are looking for an experienced and skilled teacher to teach in a mixed Year 1 / 2 class, although we do have capacity to support applications from ECTs too. A sense of fun and the ability to bring about enthusiasm in the learning environment would be essential.

The school is located on Weeton Barracks, with the majority of children coming from Service families. We presently have 125 children on roll but will have 235 children by September. More information about the school, together with a wealth of pictures, may be found on our school website.


